

Camping will be in the West Lot area of Shaker Village. Primitive camping, no electrical hookups. Horse water will be available. All vet checks will be at the camp site in the West Lot. Vetting of horses will begin on Friday at 3 o'clock p.m. until dark. Please make every effort to arrive at Shaker Village before dark on Friday. You must cross a narrow bridge located at a turn in the road, and it is much easier to cross during daylight than at night.

The trails will be primarily through rolling hills in open pasture, and will border historic rock fences. There will be a few creek crossings with plenty of rocks. However, pads are not recommended.

Shaker Village has reserved a number of rooms in the West Lot Lodge and Wash House for the ride. If you want to reserve a room, please call Ann Voris at Shaker Village 1-800-734-5611, extension 1548. For information about Shaker Village see its web site shakervillageky.org.

If you plan to arrive on Thursday, November 29, 2007, please call Don Pelly (1-800-734-5611, extension 128) so he can make camping arrangements for you. Early arrival fee of \$10.00 must be paid to Shakertown. You can pay this fee upon check in.

CANCELLATION OF RIDE

In the event of extreme temperatures, freezing rain, or a severe snowstorm, you will be notified on Thursday, November 27, 2007, that the ride has been canceled. In the event of cancellation, you will receive a refund of all ride fees except the \$20.00 deposit which is non refundable.

DIRECTIONS:

Shaker Village is located at the caution light on U.S. 68, at the intersection of KY Route 33. The entrance to Shaker Village is six miles east of the intersection of U.S. 127, Harrodsburg bypass and U.S. 68. It is not recommended that you take U.S. 68 from Lexington to Shaker Village due to the tight turns going down to the Kentucky River.

After turning into Shaker Village, turn left at the guard house, drive past the pond and keep driving on the blacktop road to the West Lot, about a 1 mile.
