

The Second Biannual Tazmanian Trot Competitive Trail Ride  
25/50 mile Elevator Saturday and Sunday  
25 mile Miles Only/16 mile Novice Ride Sunday  
June 5-6, 2010  
Paint Creek State Park  
Bainbridge, Ohio

Here we are again, continuing the fun at Paint Creek State Park. It has nothing to do with Tasmania, and the gait you ride is up to you. After Maggie Herlinsky stopped putting on the All Kidding Aside CTR at Paint Creek State Park four years ago, we wanted to make sure the opportunity to compete here continued, and so now we're putting it on. This is the third time we've sponsored it, and hope that everyone will enjoy it as much as they have in the past.

The ride is at Paint Creek State Park. The camp is primitive with little shade. Water for horse and people available in camp, but no electricity. Some camp sites have picket lines. Camp is SMALL and we are no longer allowed to use the pioneer camp, so PLEASE keep electric corrals SMALL. Donuts and drinks both mornings, and potluck dinner Saturday eve.; we'll supply meat, drinks, and dishes.

The trails are gently rolling with several steep short climbs. Most of the trails are wooded.

Out of state horses need proof of a negative Coggins test. All participants are responsible for knowing the rules; a copy will be available at the ride and at the OAATS website.

There will be completion awards for all riders finishing the ride. The open CTR will include 1st to 6th place awards in heavyweight, middleweight, lightweight and junior categories. There will also be a grand and reserve champion each day. Breed awards each day will include Best Arab, Best Half-Arab, and Best Of The Rest. Novice awards will include places 1-10, plus breed awards and junior placings. No awards other than completion will be given for the Sunday Miles Only ride. Other awards given at the discretion or whim of ride management.

Check in will begin at 3pm on Friday, June 4. Vetting in will begin when Maureen Fehrs gets there. Novice ride check in will be after the final hands-on on Saturday.

Directions: The horse camp is on Upp Road, off of US-50 between Chillicothe and Hillsboro.

From Columbus take US-23 south to Chillicothe, then US-50 west toward Bainbridge. Upp Road is about 5 miles west of Bainbridge. Look for signs to the beach and Pioneer Farm - the road sign is usually missing. From Cincinnati, take SR-32 East to 41 North at Peebles to US-50 West at Bainbridge. From Dayton take US-35 east to 41 south at Washington Courthouse to US-50 West at Bainbridge.
