

ALUM CREEK COMPETITIVE TRAIL RIDE

25/50 mile Elevator Saturday and Sunday

25 Mile Saturday Only and 15 Mile Novice Sunday

October 16-17, 2010

After a brief hiatus, the Alum Creek "Colorific" Competitive Trail Ride will take place again in October.

The ride will be held at The Alum Creek State Park Horse Trails. Check –in will begin on Friday, October 15 at 3:00 at the Alum Creek Horseman's Camp located on Howard Rd. in Delaware. Vetting in will begin shortly thereafter. Novice riders will check in on Saturday October 16 after the final hands –on.

The Horseman's Camp has limited space, so please keep portable corrals small. Picket lines are available. There is no electricity. Donuts and coffee will be provided both mornings and the Delaware OHC will have a meal available for purchase on Saturday evening.

The ride is sanctioned by OAATS and AHA and all participants are responsible for knowing the rules. The veterinary judge has final authority regarding a horse's health and ability to continue. Any veterinary treatment or farrier work is the financial responsibility of the rider or owner. Proof of a negative Coggins test is required for all out of state horses. ALL JUNIOR RIDERS MUST WEAR A HELMET.

AWARDS: Completion awards will be given to all riders successfully finishing the ride. Divisions and prizes will depend on the number of entries. Novice awards will include ribbons for placings 1-10.

ENTRY FEES: 2 Day 50 Mile Elevator - \$80.00 Adult/\$45.00 Junior
 1 Day 25 Mile Saturday - \$55.00 Adult/ \$30.00 Junior
 15 Mile Novice (Sunday)- \$35.00 Adult/\$20.00 Junior

There is a \$13.00 Grounds Fee per trailer per night for camping.
