Camping: We will be camping at the Mannington District Fair Grounds. Water is available for both horses and riders. Restrooms and showers are also available. There is a local playground and public swimming pool so bring your bathing suits to cool off!

There are 40 sites with electric hook-ups available. These sites are located close to the vet check area. These sites will be available for a \$20 per night fee and MUST BE PAID FOR IN ADVANCE! No Exceptions! The first to pre-register and pay for these sites will be the ones to have electric!

Trails: The trails are moderate in difficulty with some sections of rock. Shoes or boots are recommended! There will be plenty of water on trail. You will be riding solely on private property at all times. Please be respectful to the landowners and say thank-you when you see them! Without them, none of this is possible. The trails are mostly double track trails, with some single-track, gravel and dirt roads and lots of hills so bring your breast collars! All vet checks will be in camp!

Rules: All riders will be required to wear an approved safety helmet at all times while mounted! All AERC rules apply. Negative Coggins are required! Please...No dogs in the vet check or dining areas! The 30 minute completion rule will be in effect.

- Check-in:** Saturday, September 4th approximately 1:00pm. Vet-in to begin as soon as the vets arrive on Saturday afternoon. The rider meeting will begin around 6:00pm under the stage pavilion. No need to bring chairs. Dinner immediately to follow!
- Awards:** Completion, First to Finish, Top 10, Junior Awards, Weight Division and Best Condition awards in each distance.
- Food:** A hot meal will be served immediately following the ride meeting. Please help us by letting us know if you will be eating with us on your ride application. We would like to make sure we have enough food for everyone. Extra meal tickets available for \$10.00 per ticket.

DIRECTIONS: **DO NOT FOLLOW YOUR GPS FOR ALTERNATE ROUTES! THIS IS WV AND YOU WILL END UP ON A ONE LANE ROAD WITH NO PLACE TO TURN AROUND! FOLLOW MY DIRECTIONS AND ONLY MY DIRECTIONS! I PROMISE NOT TO GET YOU LOST!**

From North: Take I-79 South via Exit 137 East Park Ave exit, merge RIGHT onto WV-310, at first stop light, turn SLIGHT LEFT onto Merchant Street, go through three stop lights, at the FOURTH stop light, turn RIGHT onto US-250/ADAMS Street. Go through one stop light, at the second stop light, be prepared to make a TIGHT LEFT TURN onto JEFFERSON St, at the next stop light, turn LEFT onto JACKSON St. At the FIRST stop light, turn RIGHT on to US-250N, continue on US-250N for approximately 12.5 miles. As you come into Mannington, you will pass an Exxon on your left, the upcoming turn is very tight, please proceed with caution and swing wide. After you come out of this turn, be looking for WATER Street on your LEFT, merge LEFT onto Water Street, and continue to stop sign. Here you will veer LEFT onto Buffalo Street, stay on this for approximately 0.6 miles, the fairgrounds will be on your LEFT. Be looking for AERC signs!

From South: Take I-79 North via Exit 137 EAST Park Ave exit, come to stop sign, turn LEFT onto WV-310, at first stop light, turn SLIGHT LEFT onto MERCHANT Street, go through three stop lights, at the FOURTH stop light, turn RIGHT onto US-250/ADAMS Street. Go through one stop light, at the second stop light, be prepared to make a TIGHT LEFT TURN onto JEFFERSON St, at the next stop light, turn LEFT onto JACKSON St. At the FIRST stop light, turn RIGHT on to US-250N, continue on US-250N for 13.1 miles. As you come into Mannington, you will pass an Exxon on your left, the upcoming turn is very tight, please proceed with caution and swing wide. After you come out of this turn, be looking for WATER Street on your LEFT, merge LEFT onto Water Street, and continue to stop sign. Here you will veer LEFT onto BUFFALO Street; stay on this for approximately 0.6 miles, the fairgrounds will be on your LEFT. Be looking for AERC signs!
