Come join us for the 33rd annual Oak Openings Competitive Trail Ride. Our ride is a great beginner ride: just miles of flat, sandy, 2 track trails through the pine and oak forests of Oak Openings Metro Park near Swanton, Ohio. It is also a good ride for the seasoned competitor since we usually have some heat, humidity, and always plenty of deer flies! Horses should be capable of a 7mph pace. **Check in starts at 4:00pm on Friday, August 6.** Once again we are having a NOVICE ride for anyone who has never tried a Competitive Trail Ride. **THE NOVICE WILL CHECK IN ON SATURDAY, AUGUST 7.** Entrants must be at least 4 years old. The veterinary judge has final authority in all matters pertaining to the animal's ability to continue. Horses needing medical treatment are eliminated from competition. Payment of veterinary treatment or farrier work is the rider's responsibility. All riders must follow the marked course without deviations and must remain mounted for all forward progress.

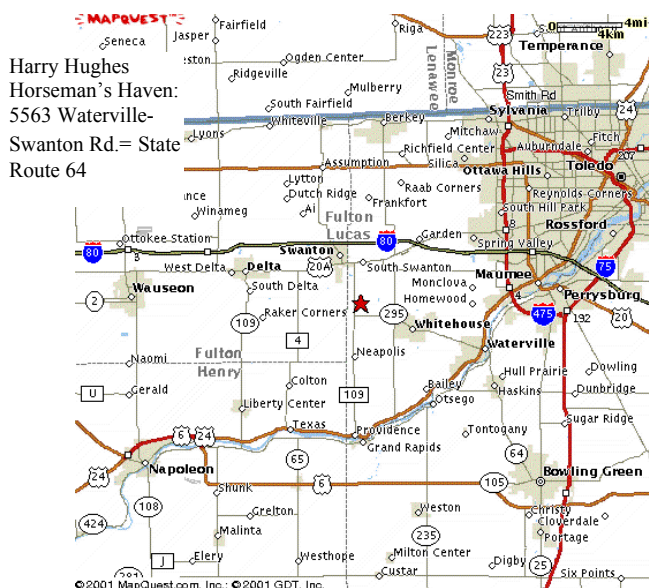

Harry Hughes Horseman's Haven: 5563 Waterville-Swanton Rd. (State Route 64). There are two driveways, you need the **North Drive**. The S drive is a private residence.

DIRECTIONS FROM:

I75 Points North: Take 475 to Airport Highway/ OH 2 West (exit 8), Turn left onto Waterville- Swanton Road/ SR 64, HHH is approx. 3 miles on left.

I75 Points South: Exit on SR 582 West (exit 187), North on SR 64 thru Waterville & Whitehouse. When SR 64 turns North at 4 way stop onto Waterville-Swanton Rd, HHH is approx. 1/2 mile on your right.

Turnpike/ 80:

Exit 52/3A for Toledo Airport. Turn right onto Airport Highway/OH2. Turn left onto Waterville-Swanton Rd/ SR64, HHH is approx. 3 miles on left.

US 24:

Turn and go North on Providence Neapolis Swanton Rd/CR-109. Follow through Neapolis, will become SR 64. HHH is approx 8.5 miles on your right
