Trail: The course winds through the Brighton Recreation Area in Michigan. The beautiful trails include hills and stream crossings. Vet checks are located in camp.

Camp: The ride camp is located at the Brighton Recreation Area Horse Camp @ 6360 Chilson Rd. Howell, MI 48843. Picket poles are available at most sites and sites are mowed.

Due to limited parking, this ride is a Pre-Entry ride. There are only 18 camping sites, however day riders are allowed. Pre-entry *REQUIRED* (regardless of whether you reserve a camping site or not) on an official OAATS ride entry form *WITH PAYMENT* postmarked by April 13th, 2012 for the Spring ride & Sept 30th, 2011 for the Fall Ride. *NO SHOW UPS PLEASE* without management approval! We will make every attempt to fit in all who wish to attend. Call the manager for approval if entry deadline has passed. All rides entered after pre-entry deadline will be assessed a \$5.00 late fee.(this includes those who have pre-entered other rides at this event). Ride entry refunds for cancellations 100% up to the ride entry deadline, 50% after.

Note: Camping fees and reservations MUST be made at the DNR web site www.michigan.gov or by calling 1-800-44-PARKS . Specific sites can now be reserved up to 6 months in advance.

From Grand Rapids/Lansing:
Take I-96 East. Take the CR-D19 exit, exit number 137, towards HOWELL/PINCKNEY. Turn RIGHT onto CR-D19.
Go about 3.5 miles. Turn LEFT onto E COON LAKE RD
Go about 3.4 miles.
Turn RIGHT onto CHILSON RD.
Go about 2.8 to camp on right.

From Flint:
Take I-75 S/US-23 S. Take US-23 S towards ANN ARBOR. Take the I-96 WEST exit, exit number 60B, towards LANSING. Take the exit, exit number 147, towards BRIGHTON. Turn RIGHT onto SPENCER RD. Go about 0.5 miles. Turn RIGHT onto E MAIN ST. Go about 0.5 miles. E MAIN ST becomes W MAIN ST. W MAIN ST becomes BRIGHTON RD. Go about 3.7 miles. Turn left on CHILSON RD. Go about 1.8 miles.

From Toledo, OH/Ann Arbor, MI
Take US-23 N. Take the M-36 exit, exit number 54B, towards PINCKNEY. Go about 5.2 miles. Look for State Park sign on right. Turn RIGHT onto CHILSON RD. Go about 3.4 miles past stables to camp on left.
(The next exit north on US23 is Silver Lake Rd. You can exit west and follow the signs to Huron Metro Park on Winans Lake Road. Winans Lake Road will take you a more direct route to Chilson where you would turn right. Please note there is a roundabout on Winans Lake Rd now.)

From Chicago
Take I-94 east to US-23 North
